Replete with more than 100 gorgeously shot photographs and introduced by texts from Jean Blanchaert, Roberto Mutti and the photographer himself, *Stefano Benazzo: Wrecks* documents and preserves shipwrecks from around the world, bound to inevitable decline in the elements to which they are exposed.

Benazzo's powerful and alluring images of these magnificent sea cathedrals — shot over the course of decades along coastlines around the globe — resurrect the memories of the sailors and immigrants they once carried.
